Community Programs

- Organized and funded All Day Summer programs at Andrews & Waiakea Uka Gym
- Supported funding for the Retired Service Volunteer Program mileage

Infrastructure

- Secured funding for the Kapiolani Street extension
- Backed renovations for the Waiakea Recreation Center
- Supported Hilo Municipal Golf Course renovations

Public Safety

- Organized and funded new lights for Kawanānakoā Field
- Advocated for additional staffing at Haihal Fire
- Secured funding for NAS Pool re-roofing
